****Kindergarten and Extended Care****

2 boxes Kleenex	Cough drops Back-

****Learning Center****

****First through Sixth Grades****

Additional Requirements/notes by Class

First Grade: No Bible, pens or loose leaf paper or binder. Will need Primary-Ruled Tablet paper.

Second Grade: Will need Primary-Ruled Tablet paper for the first quarter; then will need loose leaf paper and binder. Will not need pens.

Third Grade: Also need a spiral notebook and 5 folders with brads and pockets. Will not need pens until April.

Fourth Grade: Also need glue stick, small ziplock bags, 3x5 cards, 3 spiral notebooks, and Webster's New World Dictionary.

Fifth Grade: Erasable pens (blue or black), colored pencils, 3x5 cards, 4x6 cards, 2 Loose leaf binders (1"), 12" ruler with metric, combination lock, Webster's dictionary, Thesaurus, Highlighters, 2 spiral notebooks.

Sixth Grade: Pens (blue or black), colored pencils, 3x5 cards, 4x6 cards, 2 Loose leaf binders (1"), 12" ruler with metric, combination lock, Webster's dictionary, Thesaurus, Highlighters, 2 spiral notebooks, 2 Composition notebook for Chapel notes, compass, & protractor.

It is a good idea to have a Homework box or Homework Center at home with a Bible, paper, pens, pencils, crayons, scissors, and glue.
