These lists are general. Special or specific supplies may be needed from time to time.

### **\*\*Kindergarten and Extended Care\*\***

2 boxes Kleenex	Cough drops
2 boxes baby wipes	Backpack with name
1 bottle hand sanitizer	Change of clothing in large ziplock bag with name

*If your child is here for naps, please provide: a light blanket (labeled), perhaps a small pillow, and an additional snack (for after nap).*

### **\*\*First through Fourth Grades\*\***

King James Bible ("old" version)	Pencils- sharpened, not mechanical
Crayons- 24-count box Elmer's	Erasable pens, blue or black
white school glue Large pink eraser	12-inch ruler with centimeters
Large box baby wipes	Pencil box- snap shut, not over-sized
2 boxes Kleenex	Multi-color pack of construction paper

Cough drops	Scissors (safety-type for 1st and 2nd graders)

### Additional Requirements/notes by Class

**First Grade:** No pens or loose leaf or binder. Will need Hytone Third Grade Tab/et paper. Giant print King James Bible.

**Second Grade:** Will need Hytone Third Grade paper for the first quarter; then will need loose leaf paper and binder. Will not need pens.

**Third Grade:** Also need a spiral notebook and 5 folders with brads and pockets. Will not need pens until April.

**Fourth Grade:** Also need glue stick, small ziplock bags, 3x5 cards, 3 spiral notebooks, and Webster's New World Dictionary.

**It is a good idea to have a Homework box or Homework Center at home with a Bible, paper, pens, pencils, crayons, scissors, and glue.**
